

## **ABC Jr. Scholarship Fund:**

- Applicant must be a high school senior or a continuing education college student.
- Applicant must be a child of a single parent and/or be a single parent seeking to further his/her education.
- Applicant must be entering an accredited college, university, or vocational school and it is required to present an official letter of acceptance from the accredited college, university, or vocational school.
- Any scholarship recipients that fail to complete his/her first year of schooling MUST reimburse the Scholarship fund all scholarship monies received.
- Applicant MUST attach a copy of their W-2 form or 1040 for the most recent year. If you
  reside with a parent, please attaché their W-2 or 1040 for the most recent year.
- Applicant MUST type a 250- word essay, double spaced, describing family background, personal hardships, any community involvement/extracurricular activities, academic goals, and how this scholarship will help them reach their goals.

M. Verna Butterer Educations Scholarship/Loans: This scholarship/loans are intended for individuals who are in in financial need for educational purposes as determined by the Trustrees of the M. Verna Butterer Educational Trust. Candidates may be graduating high school seniors, persons presently attending post high school education institutions and/or non-traditional students returning to post high school institutions.
