Dear Parents/Guardians,

The district recently conducted a survey to gauge interest in instructional options for the 2021-2022 school year. Based on the results of the survey and an analysis of student progress during the past year, the district will offer the following two options in 2021-2022:

- Option A: Fully live instruction in classrooms (traditional model)
- Option B: Fully virtual asynchronous program through Bridges Online Learning

These options are separate and distinct from one another. Students who are enrolled in the fully virtual option will not attend live classes with their peers. They will however, be working toward grade level credit and a Bristol Borough School District Diploma.

The district's Health and Safety Plan for the 2021-2022 school year will reflect the latest available guidance for schools through the CDC, the PA Department of Health, and local health authorities. We will be releasing the plan for review by the end of July with adoption by the School Board in August.

If you have any specific questions regarding instructional options for next year, please contact the main office of your school or the administration office. Thank you for your cooperation and support throughout the COVID-19 Pandemic. We look forward to a return to as normal a classroom environment as possible in the fall.
