General Information:

- Schedules for orientation/meet and greet are posted on the district's website.
- Elementary school class lists are posted at the main entrance of Snyder-Girotti.

Tech Support:

There are three links on our website for tech support:

- Chromebook repair request
- Password issues
- Software issues

If you are having an issue, please click the appropriate link and fill out the Google form. A message will be sent to our tech department and you will be contacted using the email and/or phone number requested on the form.

Chromebook assignment:

- If you have a Chromebook at home it has been assigned to your child so you will not receive another one. If you have more that one child, the Chromebook in your possession has been assigned to your youngest child and your other child(ren) will receive a Chromebook. Every child will have their own Chromebook.
- If middle school or high school students have a Chromebook assigned to them in their home they should bring it to orientation charged and ready to go. Teachers will have students sign onto Chromebooks during orientation.
- Parents will be asked to sign a waiver to receive a Chromebook for their student(s).
- Chromebooks will be distributed during the meet and greets/orientations scheduled for next week. Your child(ren) will also receive other materials during this time as well.

Elementary:

- All students and parents/guardians are expected to wear an appropriate face covering during the Meet and Greet. More information regarding appropriate face covering can be found on the <u>PA Department of Health's Website.</u>
- The Meet and Greet will take place in the rear of the building at Snyder-Girotti. Classes will be organized by grade and will be labeled by teacher name.
- Class lists have been posted on the windows to the left of the main entrance. Please visit to obtain your student's teacher's name prior to attending the Meet and Greet.
- Attendance is expected at the Meet and Greet sessions. Students will be given their learning materials for remote learning.
- Daily attendance and participation in synchronous (live) instruction with the teachers is mandatory. Teachers will provide those daily schedules to students with their learning materials at the Meet and Greet.
- Students should bring back any books or other materials from last year during the Meet and Greet.

Middle School: Grades 7 & 8:

- Orientation is mandatory and counts toward a student's attendance.
- Students should enter the middle school through the rear entrance of the building near the football stadium. From there, students will be directed where to go.
- To maintain a safe social distance and cut down on building occupants, we ask that parents do not accompany their students into the building.
- All 7th and 8th student's Chromebook passwords will be changed to a generic password on Wednesday, September 9th. Students will then work with their teachers during orientation to customize their passwords. Teachers will record student passwords in case there is an issue when students go virtual.
- Students should bring back any books or other materials from last year during their orientation.
- All students are expected to wear an appropriate face covering during orientation. More

- Students will receive their class schedules at the orientation. However, you can access them from the student portal.

High School:
