Starting on Wednesday, April 1, The Bristol Borough School District will begin its continuity of education plan. Our greatest goal during the physical closure of our buildings is to stay connected and provide the resources our students need in these difficult times.

1. Teachers are currently reaching out to their students and parents. Please connect with your teachers so we can transition into this new environment as quickly as possible. Teacher emails are available on our website. If you do not have the contact information for your student's teacher(s) please call the school.
2. Grade and subject level packets will be available for all students beginning on Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. Information in the packet will cover the time span of Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> to April 8<sup>th</sup>. Students are required to participate in the learning process as part of their 4th quarter continuity of education program.
3. Grade and subject information will be available through Google Classrooms and our district website. Hard copies of packets will also be available at the school buildings between 11:00AM-1:00PM for elementary students. Google Classroom can be accessed through any number of devices, including cell phones.
4. If you have a middle/high school student who needs a paper form of an assignment, please notify the teacher so arrangements can be made.
5. Teachers will be available daily Monday through Thursday to assist students through various means, such as recorded lessons, office hours, and email.
6. Nurses and counselors will be available via email to assist in any way possible to ensure students have access to the resources they need to maintain their health and well-being. Please contact the school if you need assistance.
7. The District continues to assess the needs of students regarding technology. Please reach out to Mrs. Rosado if you need assistance with technology. We are in the process of ensuring all families have access to devices.
