I hope this correspondence finds you and your family well. It is hard to believe we will be starting our first full week of May. We hope that April showers will indeed bring May flowers and that we can all get outside and enjoy some fresh air and sunshine.

Below are the updates for the week of May 4 – May 8:

- Although the Governor will be lifting restrictions in some parts of the state, our region may stay under “stay home” restrictions longer than some of the other regions. I continue to meet with the Bucks County Intermediate Unit, legislators, and county officials to obtain the latest statistics and protocols required for the District.
- We continue to monitor the CDC requirements and state mandates to establish the guideline we need to follow to hold a graduation ceremony for our seniors. At our next board meeting, we will consider options such as staggering seniors into different time frames, changing the date, alternative venues, car parades, etc.. Our goal is to ensure we do all we can to make this day special for them and their families.

This survey will help us to assess our potential numbers for next year and allow parents to request the registration materials via email if they are not able to pick them up at the elementary school or download them from the website.
