Dear Parents/Guardians & Students,

The Bristol Borough School District will return to a hybrid instructional model on January 20, 2021. Only students who were participating in live instruction before we went to a full virtual model in November will be allowed to attend in person. Parents may choose to change their student's instructional model at the beginning of the 3rd marking period, February 1, 2021. A survey will be coming next week for parents to change their student's instructional model if they prefer a different option.

As a reminder, students who are in the RED group will attend school on Monday and Tuesday of every week. Those in the GREY group will attend school on Wednesday and Thursday of every week. Children with special needs who were in live classes 4 days a week before we went fully virtual will return to that schedule. All students are virtual on Friday. If you are unsure of your student's group, you can call the main office.
