The purpose of the Choice Board is to make reading more enjoyable. In addition, there are several questions for both fiction and nonfiction that must be answered in a notebook.

We also want the students to enrich their math skills over the summer break. By practicing math skills over the summer, the students will strengthen their math fact fluency.
