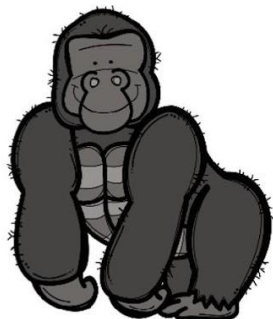
It's time to choose the animals you'd like to have in your zoo! At the top of the menus, you'll see your budget. That is the amount of money you have to spend.

You can choose however many animals you would like, as long as you do not go over your budget. Fill in your choices on the order form, and calculate the total amount you spent.

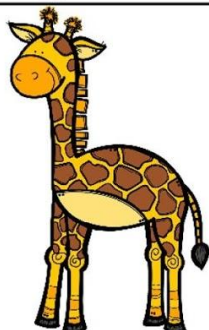
