## Your Assignment:

Over the next few weeks/months I want you to closely document **visually** your daily life in quarantine as a result of this 2019 Pandemic. If you want to do this on your phone with all photographs you may do that too.

Every Friday compile all of you thoughts, photos and drawings and write or draw a short reflection of the week. Post this reflection or visual image on google classroom. Mondays we will meet online as a class to discuss our experience.

Things to include in your visual scrapbook:

Drawings! Paintings Photographs Collages from magazines or online Poems Feelings Portraits Self-portraits

Maybe an entire day you spend in your room. Draw me a corner of your room! **Get out for a walk or run!** Take pictures of everything you see. People walking 10 feet apart. Empty shelves at the grocery store. Deserted playgrounds. What are you seeing?
